

# DIY Note Books

A perfect DIY for back to school or just for fun



The supplies you'll need are:



4 note books (I used A6)

Yellow, green, blue, red, black, gold and silver acrylic paint

Painters tape

Paint brushes

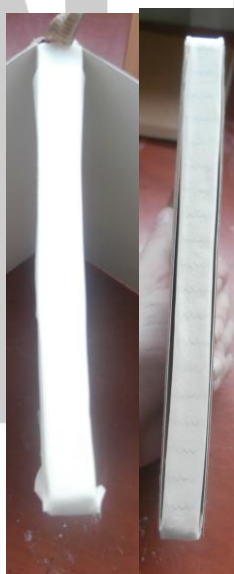
A piece of paper to put your paint on

And water to clean your brushes

First you want to tape your pages together. Open your note book and tape it like in the picture on the left and right side of the note book and do the same to the back so your pages are taped together.



Next tape the outside of the pages like in the pictures.



You can skip this step if you want but it gives you a much cleaner end result because the tape prevents that paint comes on the pages.

After you've taped the note books you can start painting them in their basic colors. With the yellow one I first painted it with 2/3 coats of white paint. Don't worry if your note books start to curl this is because of the paint but when it dries it will flatten out again. If they don't curl back you can put on some heavy books.



After the paint is dry grab your painters tape and tape down the lines. I choose to do my stripes 0,5 cm wide but you can make them as wide as you want.



Dont forget to tape the side and back as well.

When you've taped all the lines you can start painting.



Slytherin= green with silver lines

Ravenclaw= blue with silver lines

Gryffindor= red with gold lines

Hufflepuff= yellow with black lines

After about 6/7 coats of paint except for the black 3/4 coats of paint you can remove all the tape after they have dried completely.



And now your note books are done!
