Potions note book



The things you'll need are:



Different colors of acrylic paint

Paint brushes

Paint dish


a plain (brown) note book potion bottle template

an eraser

a fine liner

For the labels on the potion mix some white paint with a tiny bit of yellow and a tiny bit of brown to make a crème kind of color.

a pencil



Measure 0,5 cm between the bottom of the note book to make a 'shelf'. Fill that shelf with potion bottles with a little space between each bottle (mine have a space of 0,8 cm between them). To make the shelf above the first potion I again measured 0,5 cm between the cork of the bottles and made the bottom line and measure 0,5 cm for the top line of the shelf. Repeat these steps until the front of the note book is filled. Trace of the pencil with your fine liner.



Paint the corks in with brown mixed with a little bit of orange and fill in all of the labels with the crème color.



When the corks and labels are dry you can start to fill in the potions. I left another document with the name 'potions names and colors' with the names and colors of the potions I used for this. I filled up each potion with a different amount so I looks like some of the potions have been used. Also fill in each of the shelfs with brown. When the paint is dry use a fine liner to name each of them and if you've painted of the fine line you can retouch it (for the labels I used a 0.05 fine liner and for the potions a 0.2 fine liner).



To protect the paint and keeping it nice I covered the note book with clear self-adhesive book covering. This is not necessary but I do recommend it if you want to keep it looking nice the whole school year.
