

Pygmy Puff



The things you'll need are:



Pompoms

Black and white acrylic paint

White felt

A pen or fine liner

face and ear template

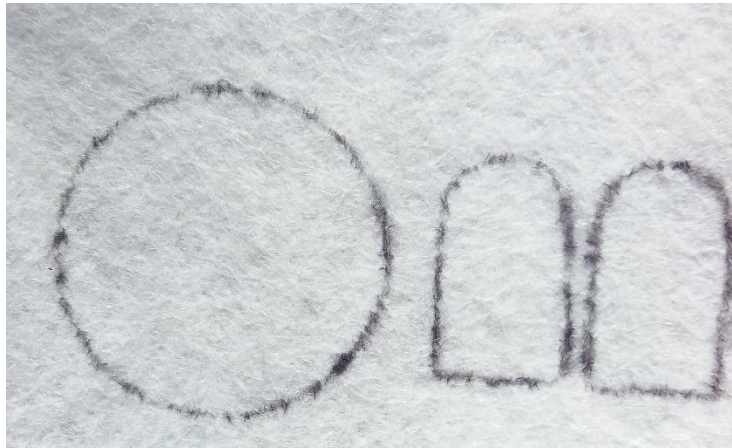
paperclip or clip

small paintbrush

toothpick

pink eyeshadow

glue



Take your white felt and trace the face and ears on it using the template and your pen or fine liner. When you've done that cut them out.



Grab one of the ears and put a little bit of glue in the middle of the ear halfway up the ear. Fold the ear in half so the sides will stick together use a paper clip or other clip to keep it together and let it dry.



Grab your circle for the face. Use some black acrylic paint and a brush to paint on the face. To make perfect circles you can use the back of a brush or a dotting tool. When the black paint is dry use a toothpick to add 2 little white dots in the eyes. Make the top dot a little bigger than the bottom dot in the eye. Use the pink eyeshadow and a small brush to add a little blush to the cheeks to make it look cute and friendly.



Glue the ears down on the back of the face. Glue them down on a slight angle. When the ears are dry put glue all over the back of the face and ears BUT don't put glue all over the ears only on the parts that are in contact with the face and not further than that. Choose a place on your pompom where you want the face to be and glue the face down.



And now your pygmy puff is done!
