

# Chocolate Frogs



the things you'll need are:



chocolate  
chocolate frog boxes  
a piping bag

a microwave safe bowl  
a spatula  
frog mold

chocolate frog cards  
a tall glass

I've left a link with the template for the boxes and a link to the chocolate frog mold.  
The information/instructions on how to make the cards and the templates I've also left on the page.





Grab your tall glass and the piping bag and put the piping bag in the glass so you can easily pour the chocolate in.



Take your chocolate and break it into little piece and place them into your microwave safe bowl. put the bowl into the microwave for 30 seconds and stir after the 30 seconds. Repeat this step until the chocolate is melted but be careful not to burn the chocolate. If it starts to bubble you've overheated/burnt the chocolate, you can prevent this: put the chocolate in the microwave for shorter time (10, 15 or 5 seconds) if it is almost melted.



when the chocolate is melted carefully pour it in your piping bag (use the spatula to help). when all of the chocolate is in the piping bag close it cut off the tip of the piping bag (do this preferably above your frog mold or bowl, because when you cut off the tip the chocolate will leak out of it immediately). fill all of the frogs, when they are all filled lightly tap your mold on your counter top to remove any bubbles.

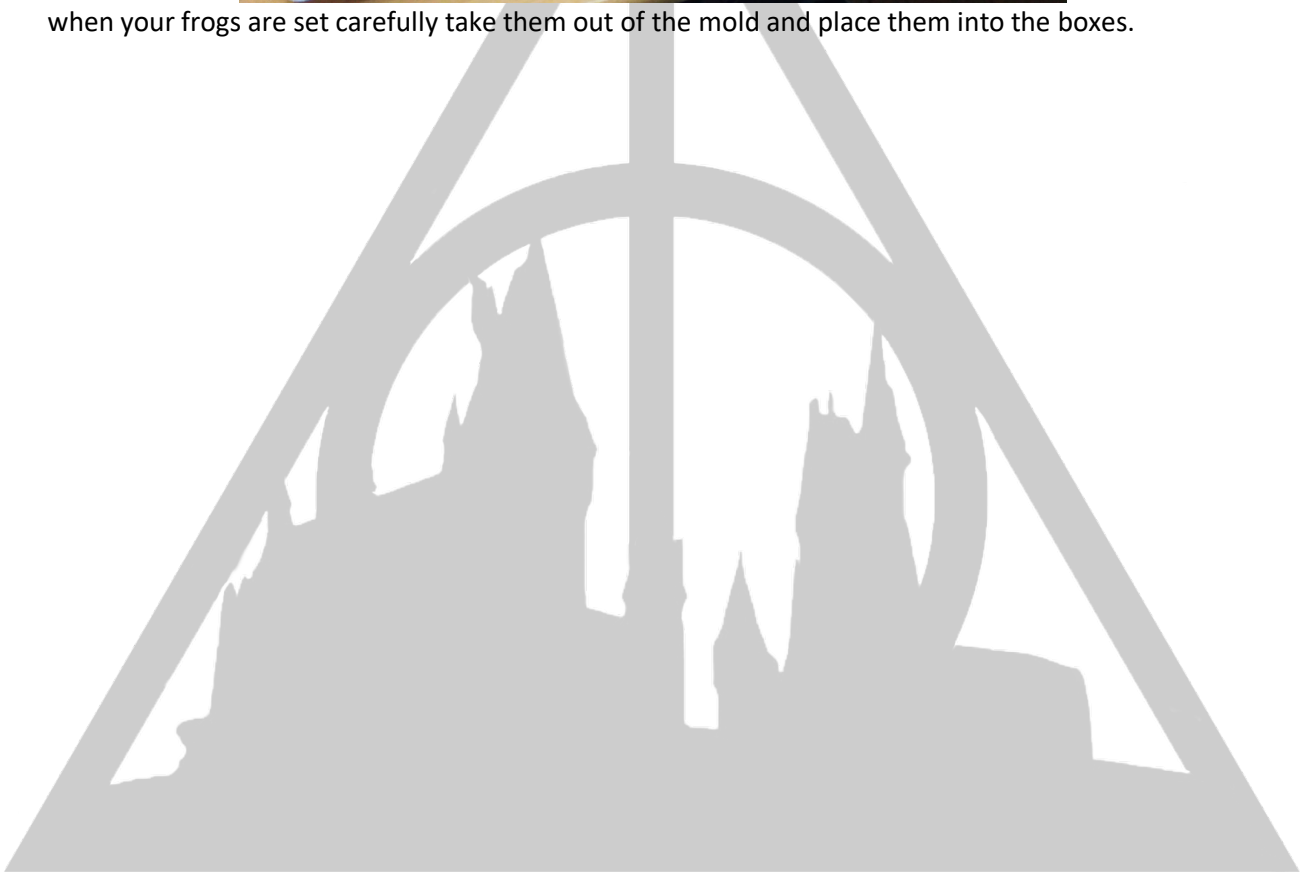
put the mold carefully into the fridge and let them set. on the recipe that I got with the mold and box templates it said the frogs will set in 30 min but mine took around 2 and a half hours so just check on them every 30 minutes or so until they are set.



While the frogs are in the fridge you can put the chocolate frog cards into the boxes



when your frogs are set carefully take them out of the mold and place them into the boxes.







and now your chocolate frogs are done!!
