

Christmas Cards



The things you'll need are:



Red, blue, green, yellow, brown, black and white thick paper

A pencil

A sponge or sponge brush

Scissors

A ruler

Black, gold, bronze and silver glitter

3D foam tape

4 popsicle sticks

an exacto knife

a small paintbrush

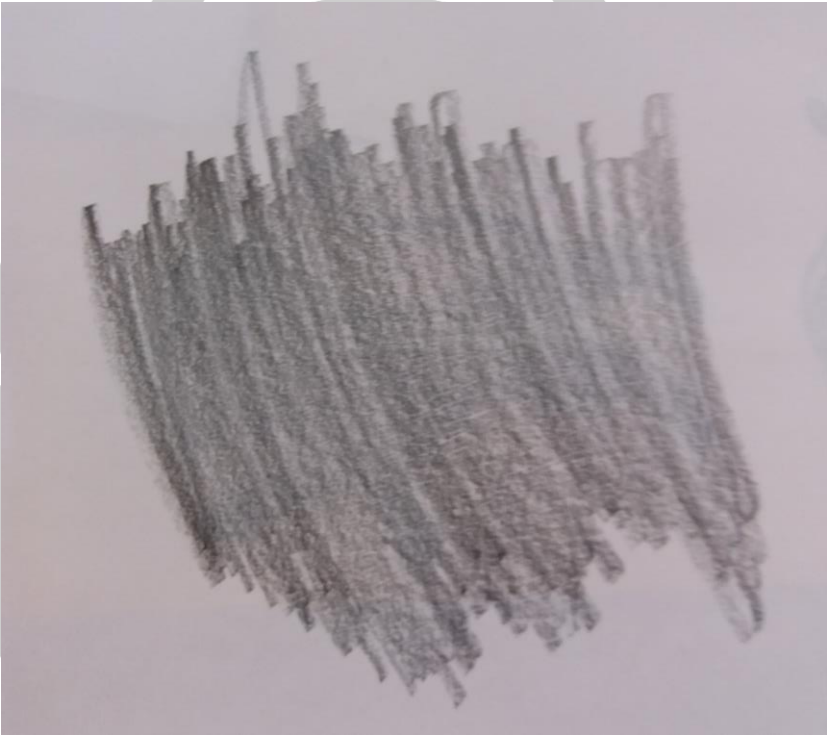
glue that dries up clear (mod podge)

a piece of paper that is 15x10 cm

Print out the silhouette of the house animals and the Christmas hats.



Fill the back of the silhouette's and the Christmas hats with your pencil.



Trace the silhouette's and the Christmas hats onto the paper.

The badger onto black. The lion onto yellow. The eagle onto brown. The snake onto white. The Christmas hats onto red.



Trace the peice of paper of 15x10 cm 2 times next to eachother onto the blue, yellow, red and green paper. Cut them out and fold it in half so you'll have a card.



Mix some glue and glitter togheter and apply thin layers onto the silhouette's until you can't see the paper anymore.

Black glitter for the badger. Gold glitter for the lion. Bronze glitter for the eagle. Silver glitter for the snake.



Do the same to the christmas hats. Start with the red part of the hat and the white part at last.



When everything is dry add the christmas hats to their rightfull animal with some glue



When the glue is dry add some 3D foam to the back of the animals.



Stick the animals onto the cards





And now your Christmas cards are done!
