

Harry potter lip balms



The supplies you'll need:



Coconut oil
Vitamin E oil
Beeswax
Flavoring oil (lemon, chocolate, orange, pumpkin, peppermint, cinnamon)
A microwave safe bowl

measuring spoon (½ teaspoon and 1 teaspoon)

lip balm tubes

a dropper

I couldn't find pumpkin and chocolate favoring oil so for the pumpkin I used pumpkin spiced and for the chocolate I used a small piece of chocolate.

Pumpkin spice:

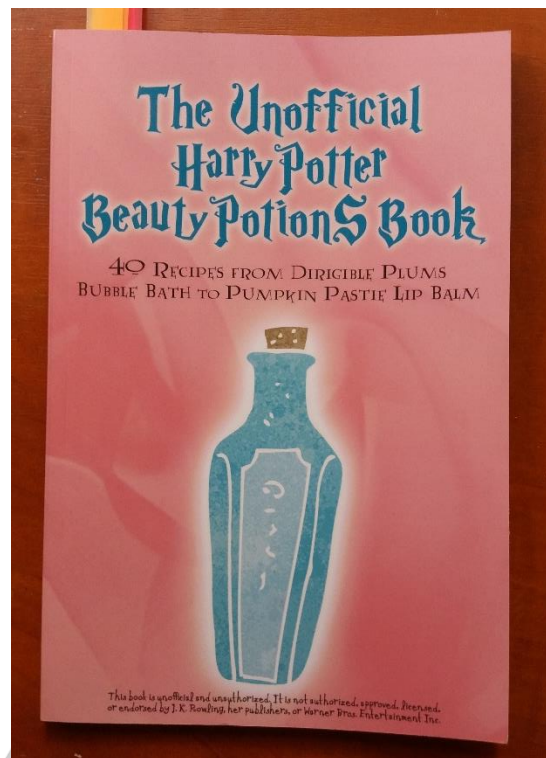
6 tablespoons ground cinnamon

4 teaspoons ground ginger

3 teaspoons ground pimento berries

3 teaspoons ground cloves

The idea to make these lip balms I got from this book:



It has some cool ideas to make harry potter themed lip balms, masks, lotions, scrubs and more. I'll leave a link to where I bought this book if you're interested in buying it.

Put 2 teaspoons of coconut oil, 1 teaspoon of beeswax, 3 drops of vitamin E oil and 2/3 drops of the flavoring oil in a microwave safe bowl.



For each lip balm it a different flavoring oil:

Sherbet lemon lip balm = lemon flavoring oil.

Chocolate frog lip balm = chocolate flavoring oil or a small piece of chocolate.

Fizzing whizbees lip balm = orange flavoring oil.

Pumpkin pasties lip balm = pumpkin flavoring oil or pumpkin spice.

Peppermint toad lip balm = peppermint flavoring oil.

Bertie Bott's every flavor lip balm = cinnamon flavoring oil.

Put the bowl with all the ingredients in the microwave for a few seconds between 5 and 10 seconds a stir it sometimes. When it's all melted grab your lip balm tube or lip balm container and put the melted lip balm mixture in it. Put in the fridge to speed up the cooling down process.



While you lip balm/ lip balms are cooling down you can make the labels.

For the labels you'll need:



Templates for the labels. You can use the one's I made or you can make your own.

Clear tape double sided tape or glue scissors

Grab you clear tape a the labels and put a layer of clear tape over the labels.



Cut out your labels and if you are using double sided tape put it on the labels.



When you lip balm is set add the labels on them.





And now your Harry Potter lip balms are done!

Have fun making these lip balms!
